

AGM 2026 – Webmaster Report

The web site of bsapuk.org has been incorporated in the global web site of basp.org.

It has provision for the Associations of Australia, Western Cape, Eastern Cape, Transvaal, KwaZulu Natal, Matabeleland, Mashonaland and the UK.

All available Outpost magazines and Newsletters from these Associations and the Rhodesian Outposts from 1911 to 1980 are available on the new bsap.org under the corresponding Association pages.

To do: -

1. The 34,000 records on the Nominal Roll on bsap.org (which constitute the principal history of the BSAP) need editing and completing. To that end people need to be tasked with researching and providing data on specific sections which can be broken down into manageable chunks.
2. Content is required on a number of pages in the website. These pages currently simply state 'Content required'.
3. Interest is being shown by some of the Associations outside the UK to be involved in bsap.org. This needs to be fostered to get them all on board.
4. To preserve the history of the BSAP, it first needs to be collected and stored in one appropriate repository. The report to the Committee on AI technology as it is at present along with its costs, will, once all the publications have been collected, be potentially out of date. It is suggested we relook at available AI technologies when we have a relatively complete body of publications to research.
5. Build a virtual online museum to house and display BSAP memorabilia and history.

To achieve this, we require: -

- 5.1 An up-to-date list of memorabilia held by or whereabouts known to members.
- 5.2 Good quality, relevant images
- 5.3 Textural content to go with the images.
- 5.4 It is proposed the museum have rooms catering for periods: -
 - 1890 -1903
 - 1904 - 1919
 - 1920 - 1947
 - 1948 - 1965
 - 1966 – 1980
